John 15:17-18. We do not fear being called narrow minded by the world. Our testimony declares we live our Christian faith without compromise. Again Jesus said, *"Enter by the narrow gate; for wide is the gate and broad is the way that leads to destruction, and there are many who go in by it "Because narrow is the gate and difficult is the way which leads to life, and there are few who find it"* Matthew 7:13-14

To fulfill the Great Commission. Everywhere the Gospel is preached, disciples of Christ should be made. Jesus said, *"But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth"* Acts 1:8.
